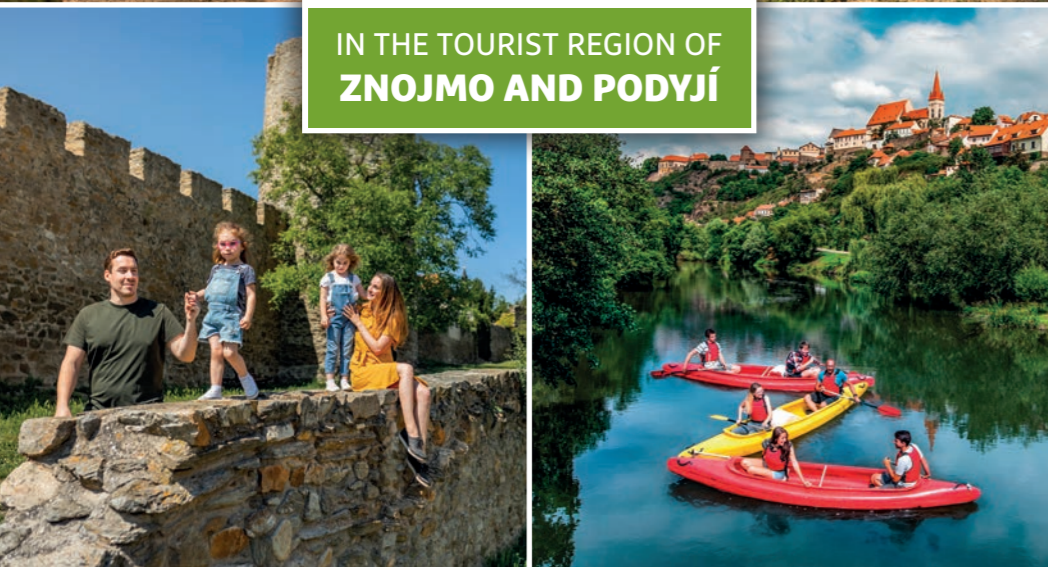

THE TOWN OF ZNOJMO

DAY 1

No visit to Znojmo is complete without experiencing the **Znojmo Underground** ④ (both the classic and adrenaline routes). Be sure to climb the **Town Hall Tower** with its observation gallery and take a guided tour of the **Castle Fortifications** ⑥. Then turn your attention to the grounds of the former Znojmo Castle, where you will find a **Brewing Exhibition** and the **Znojmo Municipal Brewery** right across the street (tours of the production process with beer tasting). If you prefer wine, you will enjoy the neighbouring **Enoteca of Znojmo Wines**. You can board the sightseeing electric bus, **Znojmaček**, in front of the entrance gate to the castle grounds (reservation required in advance!) and acquaint yourself with this royal city and its regional specialities. In the summer season, don't miss the "City in Legends" – a guided tour of the historic centre.

DAY 2

The greatest treasures of the region are the historical buildings of the **South Moravian Museum in Znojmo** – the valuable Romanesque **Rotunda of St. Catherine**, and **Znojmo Castle** on the beautiful viewing terrace, the Minorite Monastery in front of the brewery gate and the House of Art on Masaryk Square. Just a short walk away are the **Wine House** or the **Vlkova Tower** with a wine information centre and wine tastings of **VOC Znojmo**. Those looking for more action-packed entertainment can visit the **INFINITY Arena** on Masaryk Square for Laser Games and virtual reality. From one of the town's landmarks, the **Church of St. Nicholas** ①, you can then go down to Karoliny Sady/Carolina's Sets and taste local wines at the panoramic tasting gazebo in the **Rajská vinice/Paradise Vineyard**. Also stop at the new brewery Old Cock Beerhouse. You can also enjoy Znojmo's varied cultural programme (almost always accompanied by wine), such as the international **Znojmo Music Festival** (in July) or a series of events in the modern LAHOTéka Amphitheatre of the **LAHOFFER Winery** in Dobšice.

DAY 3

Jump on the red and yellow **Znojmo tourist train** ② and it will take you from the city centre to the southern suburb of Louka. There you can wonder at the monumental Baroque **Louka Monastery** ⑤ with its Znovín Znojmo wine centre, wine museum and gallery and guided tours, which include (in addition to wine tasting) a complete puzzle collection of the **Slavic epic by Alfons Mucha**. In the grounds of

Louka Monastery you will also find the multi-functional **Louka Centre** and, just a few metres away, **Louka Swimming Pool** which has a number of water attractions and is open for evening swimming.

DAY 4

Go down to the river, where you will find the Old Waterworks under the dam of the **Znojmo Reservoir**. Families with children can go from there to the **Gránické valley** Hugo the Newt and Little Red Riding Hood trail. Water lovers can rent boats and paddling equipment at the **Boating Centre** ③ and set sail on the calm and gentle river Dyje/Thaya. You can choose between a romantic ride under the medieval walls or a several-day float down the Dyje with overnight stays at the Old Waterworks, Krhovice and Hrádek campsites (bring your own tents and sleeping bags). Those who prefer to walk or cycle can take a trip to the **Podují National Park**, which is in the immediate vicinity of Znojmo.

WHEN TO COME?

Anytime – there's a rich programme of events all year round and during the holidays even every day. Most of Znojmo's sights are open on Mondays!

PODYJÍ NATIONAL PARK AND THE SOUTH ZNOJMO REGION

DAY 1

Enjoy the Znojmo wine sub-region and taste the best wines ⑤ in its renowned wine-growing villages. **Konice**, **Popice** and **Hnanice** are also the gateway to the **Podují National Park**. **Nový Šaldorf-Sedlešovice** ① and **Vrbovec** ②, where the legendary Grape Goat guards the vineyards, offer a permanent winemaker service in season. The yellow bicycle here marks a cellar open to the public. In **Satov**, where they hold a vintage 'emergency service' during the season, be sure not to miss a visit to the **Moravian wine cellar** with an educational vineyard of old varieties or the well-equipped military-historical **Area of the Czechoslovak Fortification and the Iron Curtain** ⑥. Just a short distance away you can taste wine directly in the **Peklo/Hell vineyard**, and at the state border visit the **Lampelberg** vineyard castle with its enchanting views and delicious wines.

DAY 2

You can include **Chvalovice** as a stop-off on your way to Vienna. The local **cellar lane** in the valley of the Daníž stream invites you to enjoy their fine wines; families with children will appreciate the huge **outdoor playground** and you can also take a look inside the equipped **military bunker**. Hatě, located right on the Czech-Austrian border, boasts one of the largest shopping and entertainment centres. **Merlin's Children's World** has attractions on the ground, in the air, on the water and now also has a mini-zoo called **Merlin's Farm**. The **Terra Technica Time Travel Museum** is the largest collection of musical and entertainment equipment in the world. You'll also find the **Freeport** Fashion Outlet, the largest shopping mall of its kind in Central Europe.

DAY 3

Relax in the bosom of nature and take a trip to the **Podují National Park** ⑦. Feast your eyes on breathtaking views of the **meanders**

of the **Dyje River**, heathland and wild horse pastures. The romantic ruins of **Nový Hrádek near Lukov** ⑧ have been engulfed by untamed nature. The Podují National Park Visitor Centre and the Iron Curtain Memorial can be found in **Čížov** ④; you can also try one of the many **Znovín Walking** routes for beginners and advanced walkers lead through the national park and among the vineyards with tasting arbours of Znovín Znojmo at the famous **Šobes vineyard** ⑨ or in the **Old Vineyards in Havraníky**. It's well worth the trip and the routes are great for cyclists too.

WHEN TO COME?

The most beautiful times are the lush green spring and the wonderfully colourful autumn, when you can also enjoy many wine events in the picturesque villages and cellar lanes.

WESTERN ZNOJMO REGION

DAY 1

The area is full of castles and chateaux as well as beautiful countryside and summer swimming. The main centre for tourists is the ancient town of **Vranov nad Dyjí**, proudly surrounded by its eponymous **Baroque chateau** 1 with fairy-tale interiors and a lookout tower. In season, the Vranov tourist train connects the castle, the town, the family entertainment area **V'RUN OFF' PARK** on the former chateau farm and the **Vranov Reservoir**, nicknamed the **Moravian Adriatic** 2. It is criss-crossed by the sightseeing boats of the **Vranov Boat Company** departing from the dam and the water surface is crowned with an elegant White Footbridge. Behind it you will find a large grassy sandy beach with countless accommodation and catering services. The **Vranov Beach Holiday Park** 4 is one of the best-rated campsites in the country and offers a number of festivals and sporting events. To make summer relaxation even more pleasant there are animation programmes, an original music bar on the water called **Pařník** 2 and a summer cinema at **U Karličky** restaurant. You can also try out various water sports, the rope park, or renting a boat or pedal boat, bicycle or scooter and plan your own trip around the area.

DAY 2

The second famous tourist destination is **Bitov** at the other end of the Vranov Reservoir. The majestic **Bitov Castle** 9 attracts visitors with its romantic interiors, armoury, and the largest collection of stuffed dogs in the world. You can also reach it by a sightseeing boat. In the centre of the village of Bitov, you can taste the award-winning **Tesák** beer from the **Hasičský pivovar/Firemen's Brewery** 6 or beer food specialities in the neighbouring **U Tesářů Restaurant**. From here you can also take a 12 km long cycle path named **Pivovarská 12** connecting local historical, natural and beer destinations.

DAY 3

Be sure to explore other gems in the surroundings of the **Vranov Reservoir**. The Vranovsko Cycling 3 route (57 km) connects the most important local sights, offering great views and beautiful countryside in the vicinity of the **Podyjí National Park** and the Austrian border. Explore the **ruins of Cornštejn Castle** 5 which comes alive each summer with swordsmen and cultural events, or venture further west to the little-known **Uherčice Chateau** 7 surrounded by gardens and an English park. The charming and ancient **Vratěnín** 8 lies in the westernmost corner of the South Moravian Region. Visitors are drawn to its many monuments and beauties of nature, a Postal Museum, military bunkers and a trail leading in the footsteps of the feared robber, Grasel.

WHEN TO COME?

Summer is ideal here for a holiday by the water, while spring and autumn are great for exploring its historical heritage and picturesque countryside...

NORTH ZNOJMO REGION

DAY 1

Start in **Moravský Krumlov** 1, where the Renaissance chateau with its arcades and lookout tower hosts the famous **Slavic Epic painting collection by Alfons Mucha**. Play disc golf 4 in the chateau park or head out into the beautiful and protected countryside along the Rokytná River. Climb up to the **Chapel of St. Florian** and enjoy the view. Then head to nearby **Vedrovice** 5 and try your hand at archaeology at the local museum or walk the archaeological trail 'In the Footsteps of Our Ancestors'. In **Bohutice**, let yourself be carried away by the art and mystique of the religious monuments and the exposition of the **Way of the Cross** in the local chateau. In season, be sure to stop off at **Petrovice** for a visit to the uniquely preserved **thatched cottage** 8 there.

DAY 2

Continue on to explore **Miroslav**, a region famous for apricots and wine. **Miroslav** 2 Chateau with its exhibition halls and many events is a great place to take the kids. The **Miroslav Hills** offer beautiful views. You can also taste good wine in **Damnice** or in **Horní Dunajovice**, where the reservoir of the same name invites you to relax and enjoy a summer swim. There is another reservoir in **Výrovce** and the **Pohoda** 3 campsite and swimming pool in **Únanov** offers great swimming with lots of water attractions. **Višňové** boasts a centuries-old chateau park and religious monuments and a viewpoint on Stará Hora. In **Žerotice**, the medieval castle ruins are worth a look at, and in **Tvořihráz** there's a chateau and museum with a 'walk through time'. The best way to get to know the region is by bike – the Moravian Cycle Route (43 km) is ideal for this. It will also take you to **Želetice**, where the **Old School handmade paper mill** 6 is located in the village square, offering excursions and the chance to make your own paper.

DAY 3

A little further west is the **Jevišovice** area. A rugged landscape of ancient villages, forests full of mushrooms, the romantic canyons of the Jevišovka River, and exceptional religious monuments and pilgrimage sites. **Jevišovice** – the smallest town in the South Moravian Region, will surprise you with its many heritage sights and conservation area. Visit the **Old Chateau and Forcourt** 9 with its museum exhibitions, the large chateau park by the New Chateau or head to **Jevišovice Dam**, one of the oldest in Central Europe. Continue to **Boskovštejn** with its medieval fortress, or to **Jiřice near Moravské Budějovice**, where you will find a natural meditation area and the Anička lookout tower, as well as an art gallery and a Fire Service Museum. **Hluboké Mašůvky** 7, one of our most important pilgrimage sites, deserves special attention. This large religious complex with its Lourdes Cave, a well with healing water and the miraculous statue of Our Lady of Foy in the church, attracts visitors from all over.

SOUTHEASTERN ZNOJMO REGION

DAY 1

The **Water Mill in Slup** 2 is an exceptional technical monument. This renaissance mill has 4 functional waterwheels, and the original Mill lode is also unique. In Slup you can also find the military-historical **Museum of 1938 Czechoslovak Fortifications** 6 and a small Museum of Agriculture in the local part of **Oleksovičky**. It is a wine-growing village, as is nearby **Jaroslavice** which has a Renaissance chateau and the third largest pond in Moravia. This area is criss-crossed by important **long-distance cycling routes** 9, such as the EuroVelo 13 „Iron Curtain Trail“, the Prague-Vienna Greenway and the Znojmo Wine Route, which is the longest of the **10 Moravian Wine Trails**.

DAY 2

The flat and sunny **Hrušovany** area in the east of the region is dedicated to wine and easy cycling. The local **cycling routes** are aptly named: There's 'Across the Plain', 'Fields and Vineyards' or the **Mucha cycle path**, which will lead you through the places where the young painter Alfons Mucha worked and found his inspiration. A wine cellar lane leads from **Božice to Borotice**, and **Hrušovany nad Jevišovkou** 5, a historical and tourist centre of the region, is also a wine town. At the local town hall, you can view original paintings by Alfons

Mucha that have recently been discovered. **Břežany** attracts visitors to its large chateau park and **Hevlín** 4 boasts picturesque landscape and 8 ponds. New here are the **Hevlín pedal trains** on the old railway line. The southern border is still lined with **bunkers of the Czechoslovak war fortifications**, some of which you can visit – for example those in **Dyjákovice**. In **Hrabětice**, you can see a pilgrimage site with a modern Stations of the Cross and the **Karlov** 1 Nature Reserve with its **Valley of Love**, where whole carpets of snowdrops bloom in the spring and you can enjoy a pleasant ramble.

WHEN TO COME?

Cycling and walking trips are best in spring and autumn when it's not so hot. Summer and autumn are good for wine and local folklore.
